#### Method used for determining eligibility and amount of HEERF-Student Aid funds

- Students must be Title IV eligible
  - \$100 Relocation Disbursement for dorm students
  - \$643.79 Equal disbursement for students who experienced additional financial expenses or financial loss due the COVID-19 pandemic and/or SCC's response to the pandemic.

#### Instructions to students

- SCC sent all Title IV eligible students an email notifying them of the grant and included an application for the grant with instructions as an attachment
- SCC texted and used the student announcements to notify student of the email and application
- SCC called all eligible students who had not responded to the email to ensure they received the email and to find out if they intended to apply.
